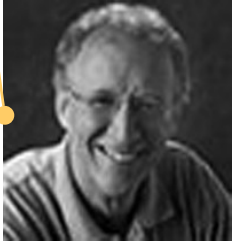


Featured Author

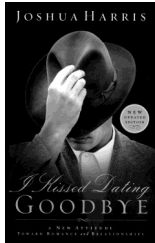
The Ancient Blockbuster

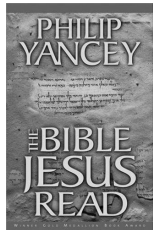


I Kissed Dating Goodbye By Joshua Harris
